## Worksheet

- 1. Fax all three documents to 1-406-432-5528 a MINIMUM of 72 hours before export. CBP requires 72 hours for document review.
- 1. Export checks can begin with faxes of the above documents; however, the ORIGINALS of all documents must be presented at the time of export.
- 1. The owner/agent must report to U.S. Customs and Border Protection with the equipment and all of the original documents at the time of export.

## **Important**

- Penalties of \$500 per vehicle will be assessed for failure to comply with the export regulations.
- . Commercial exports are only processed at the Port of Sweetgrass, daily 8am to Midnight.
- Telephones at the Port of Whitlash are only answered from 9am to 5pm (Mountain Time).
